Auditing Cable Hauling

Due to incidents relating to cable hauling, and the involvement of WorkSafe to one of the events, the VEDN have initiated the development of a training program to provide auditors with an awareness of Laying of ESI Electrical Cables (UETTDRJC21A). (Cable Hauling)

Important dates are:

10th of April 2015 introductory cable hauling auditor course for industry auditors at the Chadstone campus of Federation Training.

1st of July 2015 industry auditors that have completed the Cable Hauling auditor training will be conducting field audits as part of the training.

1st Jan 2016 the cable hauling will become an additional part of the electrical auditing process.

Mechanical Cable Hauling

The VEDN have initiated the development of a training course to provide VESI civil employees and Civil Contractors with the national competency “Laying of ESI Electrical Cables (UETTDRJC21A).” (Cable Hauling)

1st of Jan 2016 VEDN related Cable Hauling will only be undertaken by crews that have the national competency (or equivalent) for Laying ESI Electrical Cables (**UETTDRJC21A**)

Companies that do not hold the competency “Laying of ESI Electrical Cables (UETTDRJC21A).” will not be reaccredited for mechanical cable hauling.

VESI Pole to pit, contractors **who install** cables by hand **do not** need to undertake the training course

Additional **civil cable hauling** courses for VESI employees/contractors are planned for September 2015
