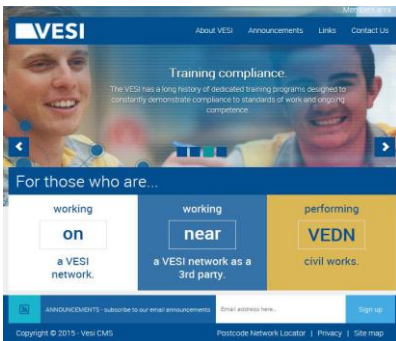
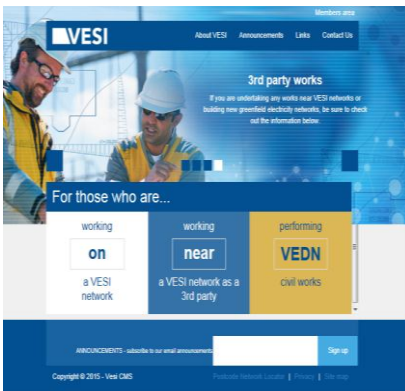

Cable Hauling Auditing

During July to Dec 2015 the trial of auditing Laying ESI Electrical Cables (Cable Hauling) began with the introduction of the VEDN audit checklist.

Important dates are:

As of the 1st of July

Cable Hauling Auditing has begun.

In September 2015

2nd cable hauling auditor course for industry auditors will be conducted at the Chadstone campus of Federation Training.

On the 1st Jan 2016

Cable hauling will become an integrated part of the network electrical auditing process.

Cable Hauling Auditing

From June to September several companies will undertake the training course to provide employees and contractors with the national competency "Laying of ESI Electrical Cables (UETTDRJ21A)." (Cable Hauling)

From the 1st of Jan 2016 VEDN related Cable Hauling will only be undertaken by crews that have the national competency (or equivalent) for Laying ESI Electrical Cables. (UETTDRJ21A)

Companies that do not hold the competency "Laying of ESI Electrical Cables (UETTDRJ21A)." will not be reaccredited for mechanical cable hauling.

VESI Pole to pit, contractors who install cables by non-mechanical means do not need to undertake the training course.

Non VESI contractors can contact Federation Training or other Training Organisations that have (UETTDRJ21A) in their scope of training.
