Subject:	UPDATED VESI WEBSITE

In September 2014, a program commenced to update the VESI website. That work is now complete and the website has been refreshed with a new look and an easy navigation system. The new website will launch within the next 24 hours.

Information is now categorised and displayed according to the following key areas:

Category	Purpose	Examples
Working ON a network	contains information relevant to companies working directly on the network for a network operator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Green Book Skills & Training, Network Access Work Practices including the Fieldworkers Handbook, HV Live Work, Installations & Connections
Working NEAR a network	contains information for third parties who are working near or in the vicinity of a network	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No Go Zones Shared use Code of Practice Construction Interface Guideline
VEDN	contains information for contractors involved in the civil aspects of underground electrical infrastructure	

The following information is provided for your assistance when initially accessing the site:

- The website address remains the same www.vesi.com.au
- The site has been designed for use on iPhones, tablets etc. and is therefore responsive to your device
- To go to the HOME page: Click on the VESI logo
- To submit a Contact Us form: Click on the Contact Us, located in the top right hand corner of the website, complete the details and select the appropriate area using the drop down list
- A history of the VESI can be found in about VESI

The new RSS function has not yet been enabled however we will advise you as soon as that update is complete at which time you will need to resubscribe.
